Shoppability Project

Isaac Street Reconstruction

Downtown Flower Pots

The flower pots will be replaced with self watering versions. They require significantly less labour as they are watered weekly or every two weeks (for ground pots) rather than daily, and hanging baskets are watered twice a week instead of daily.
