## Jeff Roy motioned to pass the minutes from the August BIA meeting. Dan Colquhoun seconded.

**News from Council (Moved ahead on schedule so Dan could share before the council Meeting).** Kim Leech's position has been terminated in both Municipalities. Council will be discussing this decision at their meeting tonight. Questions we would like Dan to take to council from the BIA...

Who will do Kim's work – she had begun the revitalization plans? Already was working on Façade updates for many downtown locations that the BIA had agreed to fund.

-will these plans for Central Huron facades go forward?

- Jeff's concern - we have had no assistance for 8-9 months, we are once again in a stall position on many of our planned activities

- the BIA is not in agreement with sharing one EDO position with another Municipality. There is just too much to do in either location to make this a viable alternative.

#### 2.0 Chatter from the Chairs – Tricia

Website update – Craig to do presentation on the new Website in October – 2.1CIC, Revitalization & Branding Update – The brand being looked at for Central Huron is "Local by Nature" (wildlife areas, scenery, yellow brick is from local clay... Council will vote on the proposal and then we will move ahead with their decisions.

**2.2Library** – Clinton's Library was not accredited in the assessment done this year. It is considered to be too small, not accessible...recommend to move to a) recreation centre to make a "knowledge district" close to all the schools or b) Omaf offices will be vacant soon...or c) add onto existing building, possibly working into Town Hall

Then there is the opportunity to use the Library building as a heritage hotel/restaurant.

Council wants our opinion on location of Library...is it important to keep it downtown?

\*\*Marilyn Tyndall would like to see the Library do a survey of their patrons to see where they come from...walk ins, drive from a distance? How would location affect them?
